**ORDER RE LEAD PLAINTIFF'S APPLICATION FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A
LETTER OF REQUEST PURSUANT TO THE HAGUE CONVENTION**

The Court, having considered Lead Plaintiff's Application for the Issuance of a Letter of Request to obtain testimony from Richard Oldfield for trial, and the supporting papers, FINDS as follows:

That Richard Oldfield possesses evidence that would, at trial, aid in the establishment of facts surrounding Lead Plaintiff's claims in this action;

That the evidence that Richard Oldfield possesses is only available to Lead Plaintiff in the United Kingdom;

That Lead Plaintiff would be unable to obtain such evidence unless assisted by the appropriate authority in the United Kingdom; and

That Lead Plaintiff has shown good cause for the issuance of the Letter of Request.

Accordingly, it is ORDERED that Lead Plaintiff's Application for the Issuance of a Letter of Request pursuant to the Hague Convention is GRANTED.
