
ORDER

Just filed and pending before the Court in the above referenced cause is Deutsche Bank Entities' motion for expedited consideration of and motion for suspension of deadline to answer Lead Plaintiff's First Amended Complaint because they are also filing a motion for partial reconsideration and dismissal relating to the Court's July 26, 2005 Opinion and Order and, in the alternative motion to require a Second Amended Complaint before they are required to respond to Lead Plaintiff's First Amended Complaint.
