

agree that under the circumstances, plaintiffs should likewise receive five additional business days to submit a reply to the DB Entities' opposition.

Accordingly, the DB Entities' opposition to plaintiffs' Reconsideration Motion would be due May 17, 2004 and plaintiffs' reply, if any, to the DB Entities' opposition would be due on June 7, 2004.

The DB Entities believe that this extension of time is reasonable and will not prejudice any party to this litigation.

CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reasons, the DB Entities respectfully request that the Court grant this unopposed motion and enter an order extending the date by which defendants must respond to Lead Plaintiff's Motion for Reconsideration of Order Dismissing Claims Against the Deutsche Bank Defendants to May 17, 2004 and the date by which plaintiffs must respond to the DB Entities' opposition to June 7, 2004.
