**ORDER**

Plaintiff Fugro McClelland Marine Geosciences, Inc.’s (FMMG’s) opposed motion for enlargement of time to respond to the motion for summary judgment of defendant Steadfast Insurance (Dkt. 25) is denied.

FMMG does not contend that they are unable to respond by the deadline or that discovery is necessary. FMMG’s position is that if its pending motion to enforce settlement (Dkt. 7) is granted, the summary judgment motion will be moot. However, if that motion is denied, a prompt resolution of the motion for summary judgment will be in the interests of justice. The court finds there is no good cause for the extension FMMG requests.<sup>1</sup> The court will extend FMMG’s response date by one week to compensate for the time during which this motion for extension was pending. It is therefore
