I.

ii.

Randomly reassign 25 civil cases from the docket of each active judge in the Houston Division, to equate the civil docket of Judge Kent with that of the average number of pending civil cases per judge in the Houston Division.

Transfer all criminal cases pending in the Galveston Division to the docket of Judge Kent.

IV.

Place Judge Kent's name in the random draw of civil and criminal cases effective November 1, 1990, in accordance with the Third Amended Division of Work Order to be entered.
