THIRD GENERAL ORDER CONCERNING HURRICANE HARVEY

The Clerk's Office opens for normal business on Tuesday, September 5, 2017. Due to the severe flooding caused by Hurricane Harvey, however, a significant number of CM/ECF users do not have access to their computer servers and other equipment necessary to use the Court's electronic filing system. Some roadways remain impassible. These circumstances should not be the basis for an adverse legal decision. In recognition of these realities and for purposes of Bankruptcy Rule 9006(a)(3) only, the Clerk's Office is declared to be inaccessible from Monday, August 28, 2017 through Friday, September 8, 2017.

Any temporary stay imposed under 11 U.S.C. § 362(c) is extended pending further order by the presiding judge.

This Order applies to all cases and proceedings pending in the Galveston, Houston and Victoria Divisions of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Texas.
