ORDERED that the Honorable Mary Rose Milloy be, and she hereby is, appointed a United States Magistrate Judge with official station at Houston, Texas at the salary as fixed by the Judicial Conference of the United States. The said United States Magistrate is to hold and discharge the duties of said office for a term of eight (8) years from the date she assumes office unless sooner removed, pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 631(i).
