attorneys, however, are not relieved from satisfying the other requirements for admission stipulated

in the Local Rules of this Court. It is further ORDERED that this fee waiver only applies so long

as the attorney remains employed by one of the offices mentioned above. If such employment

ceases, the attorney shall forthwith notify the Clerk of this Court and must then tender the

appropriate admissions fee or be terminated from membership in our Bar.
