

ORDER

The Internal Revenue Service routinely files proofs of claim in bankruptcy cases pending in this Court. The Administrative Procedures for Filing, Signing, and Verifying of Documents by Electronic Means in Texas Bankruptcy Courts, Section I.C., adopted December 1, 2004, provides that any creditor who routinely files claims and other documents in any authorizing court may be required to become an electronic filer.

Accordingly, it is ORDERED that the Internal Revenue Service is required to become an electronic filer for the purpose of filing claims in bankruptcy cases pending in this district, and any claim filed by it after October 31, 2005 must be electronically filed.
