**AGREED STIPULATION AND ORDER REGARDING CSFB'S SUPPLEMENTAL
RESPONSES TO LEAD PLAINTIFF'S INTERROGATORY NOS. 14 AND 15**

WHEREAS, on June 20, 2003, Lead Plaintiff The Regents of the University of California ("Lead Plaintiff") served on Credit Suisse First Boston LLC, Credit Suisse First Boston (USA), Inc. and Pershing LLC (collectively, "CSFB") Plaintiffs' First Set of Interrogatories (the "Interrogatories");

WHEREAS, on July 21, 2003, CSFB served its Responses and Objections to the Interrogatories, in which CSFB objected to responding to Interrogatory Nos. 14 and 15 on the grounds that, among other things, both interrogatories were premature contention interrogatories;

WHEREAS, Lead Plaintiff and CSFB have agreed that CSFB will supplement its responses to Interrogatory Nos. 14 and 15 on or before December 22, 2005, and that Lead Plaintiff expressly reserves the right to seek additional supplementation of those responses if necessary;

WHEREAS, CSFB has expressly preserved all of its other objections to Interrogatory Nos. 14 and 15;

IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED, CONSENTED TO AND AGREED, by and among counsel for the parties herein, and it is hereby ORDERED by the Court that CSFB will supplement its responses to Interrogatory Nos. 14 and 15 of the Interrogatories on or before December 22, 2005, and that this Stipulation and Order does not modify the current discovery schedule in any other way.


