
**ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANT CITIGROUP INC.'S MOTION FOR ENTRY
OF AN AMENDED ORDER WITH RESPECT TO ITS MOTION FOR A
PROTECTIVE ORDER SEEKING CONFIDENTIAL TREATMENT OF
CERTAIN DEPOSITION EXHIBITS AND TESTIMONY OF ADAM KULICK**

Having considered Defendant Citigroup Inc.'s Motion for Entry of an Amended Order with Respect to its Motion for a Protective Order Seeking Confidential Treatment of Certain Deposition Exhibits and Testimony of Adam Kulick (Dkt.# 2881), the Court finds that the Motion should be, and hereby is, GRANTED. This Order amends and takes the place of the Order entered on February 3, 2005 (Dkt. # 3047).
