ORDER

Pursuant to the amendments to Local Rule 83.1, which were adopted on May 25, 2023, commencing August 1, 2023, attorneys who file a Motion to Appear Pro Hac Vice will pay a \$100.00 local fee.

General Order 2000-4 exempts attorneys employed by any United States Attorney's Office, the Federal Public Defender's Office, or the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Texas from paying the admission fee. These attorneys are also exempt from paying the pro hac vice admission fee.

An attorney in good standing is encouraged to apply to be a member of the Bar of the Southern District of Texas by completing forms prepared by the Clerk and approved by the United States District Court.

Pending consideration of an application (either for pro hac vice or for admission), an attorney may appear, subject to the discretion of the presiding judge.
