ORDER

In accordance with the authority conferred by 28 U.S.C. If 631 et seq. and the further authority granted and action taken by the Judicial Conference of the United States, it is

ORDERED that the Nonorable Frances H. Stacy, be, and she hereby is, appointed as a full-time United States Magistrate with official station at Houston, Texas, at the salary as fixed by the Judicial Conference of the United States. The said Magistrate shall enter upon the performance of her duties at 12:01 A.M. on the 20th day of February, 1990, but prior to the commencement of such duties, she shall take the oath or affinwtion as prescribed by 28 U.S.C. If 453 and 631(g).

The said full-time United States Magistrate is to hold and discharge the duties of said office for a term of eight (8) years from the date she assumes office unless sooner removed, pursuant to the provision of 28 U.S.C. I 631(i).
