On october 3, 1990, this Court entered General Order No. 90-31 appointing a receiver as authorized by the Texas Turnover Statute, TEX. CIV-PRAC- & REM- CODE ANN SS 31-002 to act in behalf of the United States. counsel for the government represented that such appointment was appropriate in light of an anticipated large volume of collections from judgment debtors on a continuing and ongoing basis. The Court has now been advised by the United States Attorney that a recent opinion of the Texas Supreme Court substantially limits the applicability of the Turnover Statute in the Government's post-judgment collection efforts and there is no likelihood of massive numbers of collections necessitating the appointment of a continuing receiver and it is accordingly,

ORDERED by the Court that General Order No. 90-31 entered on October 3, 1990, is hereby RESCINDED.
