GENERAL ORDER NO. 92-23

ORDER

In accordance with the authority conferred by 28 U.S.C. §§ 631 et seq. and the further authority granted and action taken by the Judicial Conference of the United States, it is

ORDERED that the Honorable Marcia Ann Crone be, and she hereby is, appointed a United States Magistrate Judge with official station at Houston, Texas at the salary as fixed by the Judicial Conference of the United States. The said Magistrate Judge shall enter upon the performance of her duties at 12:01 a.m. on the 7th day of August, 1992, but prior to the commencement of such duties, she shall take the oath or affirmation as prescribed by 28 U.S.C. §§ 453 and 631 (g).

The said United States Magistrate is to hold and discharge the duties of said office for a term of eight (8) years from the date she assumes office unless sooner removed, pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 631(i).

This ORDER is being entered by the undersigned as Chief Judge, with the unanimous consent of all the judges of this court.
