GENERAL ORDER NO. 92-29

ORDER

In accordance with the authority conferred by 28 U.S.C. §§ 631 et seq. and the further authority granted and action taken by the Judicial Conference of the United States, it is

ORDERED that the Honorable John William Black be, and he hereby is, appointed a United States Magistrate Judge with official station at Brownsville, Texas at the salary as fixed by the Judicial Conference of the United States. The said Magistrate Judge shall enter upon the performance of his duties at 12:01 a.m. on the 18th day of September, 1992, but prior to the commencement of such duties, he shall take the oath or affirmation as prescribed by 28 U.S.C. §§ 453 and 631(g).

The said United States Magistrate is to hold and discharge the duties of said office for a term of eight (8) years from the date he assumes office unless sooner removed, pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 631(i).

This ORDER is being entered by the undersigned as Chief Judge, with the unanimous consent of all the judges of this court.

The Clerk will furnish certified copies of this order to the several divisions of this Court, to the United States Magistrate Judge John William Black, and to the Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts, as provided by 28 U.S.C. § 631 (h) .
