GENERAL ORDER 2018-1

ORDER REGARDING COMPLEX CASE ASSIGNMENT

By vote of the Bankruptcy Judges, the Court orders:

1. Chapter 11 cases that are designated for administration as complex chapter 11 cases will be assigned on a consolidated docket across all divisions within the Southern District of Texas.
2. The Clerk is directed to assign complex chapter 11 cases randomly between a panel of two bankruptcy judges. The complex case panel will be designated by the Court from time-to-time by a majority vote of the Bankruptcy Judges.
3. The judge to whom the case is assigned will designate the appropriate divisional location for hearings.
4. The complex case panel shall initially consist of Chief Judge David R. Jones and Bankruptcy Judge Marvin Isgur.
5. This order governs over any conflict with any present or future work order.
6. This Order is issued pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 154(a). It is effective on entry.
