ORDER NO. <u>93-5</u>

Pursuant to the Jury Selection and Service Act of 1968 (28 U.S.C.A. Section 1861, et seq.) and to the Plan for Jury Selection for the Southern District of Texas, filed on March 2, 1981, and subsequent amendments thereto, for the purpose of refilling the master wheel for each of the seven divisions of this Court pursuant to such Plan, it is ordered as follows:

The Clerk will select, in the manner provided by such Plan, names from the voter registration list for the divisions in the approximate numbers as listed below for placement in the master wheel of such divisions:

HOUSTON DIVISION	105,340
BROWNSVILLE DIVISION	36,542
CORPUS CHRISTI DIVISION	86,420
GALVESTON DIVISION	56,845
LAREDO DIVISION	33,866
MCALLEN DIVISION	85,808

VICTORIA DIVISION

The Court entertaining the view that on this initial refilling of the wheel a number of names substantially in excess of the minimum should be secured for the master wheel, it is further ordered that all such names drawn shall be drawn from the voter registration list existing in each division and a jury qualification form sent by mail to each of those selected and drawn in quantities as directed by the Clerk of this Court.

On return of the questionnaire, the Clerk will determine, in the manner provided in the Act and in the Plan, those prospective jurors who are qualified, are not exempt, and are not excused; and he will report such determination, together with his recommendation, to the Court.

Thereafter, the Court will order that those names, or their identifying number, found to be qualified, not exempt, and not excused shall be placed in the qualified wheel for service to this Court.
