ORDER AUTHORIZING WITHDRAWAL OF EXCESS SECURITIES

Upon the attached application of Chemical Bank (formerly Manufacturers Hanover Trust Company) for Ordering Authorizing Withdrawal of Securities, and it appearing there are excess securities pledged under 11 U.S.C. §345,
