ORDER

By the authority of 28 U.S.C. 631 et sea. and after compliance with the requirements established by the Judicial Conference of the United States, it is

ORDERED that the Honorable William M. Mallet be, and he is reappointed as United States Magistrate Judge with official station at McAllen, Texas at the salary fixed by law. The said Magistrate Judge shall enter upon the performance of his duties at 12:01 a.m. on the 18th day of January, 1995, provided that, prior to the commencement of such duties, he shall take the oath or affirmation as prescribed by 28 U.S.C. S 453 and 631(g).

The said United States Magistrate Judge is to hold the office for a term of eight (8) years from the date he assumes office unless sooner removed pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. 631(i).

The ORDER is being entered by the undersigned as Chief Judge with the unanimous consent of all the judges of this Court.

The Clerk will furnish certified copies of this Order to the several divisions of this court, to United States Magistrate Judge William M. Mallet, and to the Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts, as provided by 28 U.S.C. S 631 (h) .
