ORDER ON TRANSCRIPT FEES

These are the maximum page rates for all transcripts prepared by official court reporters and official transcribing services throughout the Southern District of Texas, whether privately paid or government paid, whether in bankruptcy court or district court, for all transcripts ordered after April 13, 1992.

<i>Ordinary</i> (Delivery within 30 calendar days after receipt of order.)	\$3.00	\$0.75	\$0.50
<i>Expedited</i> (Delivery within 7 calendar days after receipt of order.)	\$4.00	\$0.75	\$0.50
<i>Daily</i> (Delivery before the normal opening hour of court on the following morning whether it is a court day.)	\$5.00	\$1.00	\$0.75
<i>Hourly</i> (Delivery within 2 hours.)	\$6.00	\$1.00	\$0.75

These rates do not alter the Judicial Conference rates to be paid from Criminal Justice Act funds for more than one copy of a transcript of the same proceeding ordered in multi-defendant cases.
