ORDER

By the authority of 28 U. S. C. §63 et seq., with the approval of the court, and after compliance with the requirements established by the Judicial Conference of the United States, it is ORDERED that Jane Cooper-Hill be, and she is hereby appointed as United States Magistrate Judge with official station at Corpus Christi, Texas, at the salary fixed by law. This appointment is effective 12:01 a.m. on the 10th day of February, 1997, provided that, prior to the commencement of her duties, she shall take the oath or affirmation as prescribed by 28 U.S.C. §§453 and 63 l(g).

The said United States Magistrate Judge is to hold the office for a term of eight (8) years from the date she assumes office, unless sooner removed pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. §631 (i).

The Clerk will furnish copies of this Order to the district judges and magistrate judges of this Court and to the appointee. Notice shall be given to the Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts, as provided by 28 U.S.C. §631 (h).
