ORDER

1. By General Order 2017-3, the Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Texas established a Complex Case Committee to (i) review and recommend changes to the existing Procedures for Complex Chapter 11 Bankruptcy Cases; and (ii) consider and propose procedures for complex chapter 15 and chapter 7 cases as appropriate.
