GENERAL ORDER NO. 2000-4

ORDER

As resolved by a majority of the active district judges at a meeting on May 8, 2000, it is ORDERED that attorneys employed by any United States Attorney's Office or Federal Public Defender's Office and attorneys employed by the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Texas may be admitted to the Bar of this Court without paying the stipulated admissions fee. Such attorneys, however, are not relieved from satisfying the other requirements for admission stipulated in the Local Rules of this Court. It is further ORDERED that this fee waiver only applies so long as the attorney remains employed by one of the offices mentioned above. If such employment ceases, the attorney shall forthwith notify the Clerk of this Court and must then tender the appropriate admissions fee or be terminated from membership in our Bar.
