ORDER

Under the authority of 28 U.S.C. §631 et seq., with the approval of the Court, and after compliance with the requirements established by the Judicial Conference of the United States, it is

ORDERED that Peter E. Ormsby be, and he is hereby reappointed as United States Magistrate Judge with official station at McAllen, Texas at the salary fixed by law. Magistrate Judge Ormsby shall enter upon the performance of his duties at 12:01 a.m. on the 5th day of October, 2000, provided that, prior to the commencement of such duties, he shall take the oath or affirmation as prescribed by 28 U.S.C. §§453 and 631(g).

Magistrate Judge Ormsby is to hold the office for a term of eight (8) years from the date he assumes office, unless sooner removed pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. §631(i).

The Clerk will furnish certified copies of this Order to the several divisions of this Court, to United States Magistrate Judge Ormsby, and to the Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts, as provided by 28 U.S.C. §631(h).
