ORDER

Under the authority of 28 U.S.C. §631 et seq., with the approval of the Court, and after compliance with the requirements established by the Judicial Conference of the United States, it is

ORDERED that Maryrose Milloy be, and she is hereby reappointed as United States Magistrate Judge with official station at Houston, Texas at the salary fixed by law. Magistrate Judge Milloy shall enter upon the performance of her duties at 12:01 a.m. on the 27th day of October, 2000, provided that, prior to the commencement of such duties, she shall take the oath or affirmation as prescribed by 28 U.S.C. §§453 and 631(g).

Magistrate Judge Milloy is to hold the office for a term of eight (8) years from the date she assumes office, unless sooner removed pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. §631(I).

The Clerk will furnish certified copies of this Order to the several divisions of this Court, to United States Magistrate Judge Milloy, and to the Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts, as provided by 28 U.S.C. §631(h).
