GENERAL ORDER NO. 2004-8

ORDER

Under the authority of 28 U.S.C. §631 et seq., with the approval of the Court, and after compliance with the requirements established by the Judicial Conference of the United States, it is

ORDERED that B. Janice Ellington be, and she is hereby reappointed as United States Magistrate Judge with official station at Corpus Christi, Texas at the salary fixed by law. Magistrate Judge Ellington shall enter upon the performance of her duties at 12:01 a.m. on the 14th day of November, 2004, provided that, prior to the commencement of such duties, she shall take the oath or affirmation as prescribed by 28 U.S.C. §§453 and 631(g).

Magistrate Judge Ellington is to hold the office for a term of eight (8) years from the date she assumes office, unless sooner removed pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. §631(i).
