CrLR49. FILING OF-PAPERS REQUIREMENTS

CrLR49.1 Place of Filing. Papers are filed by delivery of the original to the clerk not to the judge.

— CrLR49.2 Original and Copy. An original and one copy of each document to be filed in a case must be provided to the clerk at the time of filing.

The provisions of LR5 with respect to electronic filing and service in civil cases are applicable to criminal cases.
