ORDER VACATING GENERAL ORDER 2021-1 REGARDING THE FILING OF SEALED DOCUMENTS

- 1. Pending further order, this Order governs the filing of sealed documents.
- 2. General Order 2021-1 is vacated.
- 3. The suspension of Local Bankruptcy Rule 9037-1 is terminated. Except as modified by paragraph 4 of this Order, Local Bankruptcy Rule 9037-1 is fully reinstated.
- 4. If a document must be filed that contains or references confidential information that is likely to be used by a hostile foreign government or its intelligence service to harm the interests of the United States, or is likely to be used to commit foreign or domestic crimes, then the offering party should seek emergency relief regarding the handling of such document.
- 5. Beginning September 7, 2021 unless otherwise ordered, the Clerk will begin transferring paper documents filed under seal pursuant to General Order 2021-1 to the Court's electronic docket in compliance with Local Bankruptcy Rule 9037-1. Any party-in-interest that objects to the transfer of any manually sealed document must file an objection not later than August 23, 2021.
