## SPECIAL ORDER CONCERNING ADMISSION OF ATTORNEYS AND ELECTRONIC FILING TRAINING CLASS

On this date, the undersigned considered sua sponte the proposal of the Texas Young Lawyers Association concerning the admission of attorneys to practice before this Court and the certification class required to be taken before use of the Court's Electronic Filing System. It appearing to be in the best interest of the administration of justice that this proposal be adopted,

It is hereby ORDERED that any approved applicant for admission to this Court who, no later than May 22, 2010, attends the entire 2009 Federal Court Practice Course sponsored by the Texas Young Lawyers Association and TexasBarCLE, to be presented in each of the four federal Districts of Texas from May to July 2009, shall be deemed to have fulfilled the:

- (1) Educational requirements for admission set forth in S.D. Tex. L.R. 83.1(G); and
- (2) The Court's Electronic Filing System certification class requisite to receiving electronic filing privileges, which addresses signature and notice issues, reviews the Administrative Procedures for Electronic Filing and provides a demonstration of the system.

It is further ORDERED that proof of full attendance at the Court may be evidenced by the applicant's submission of a "Certificate of Attendance" which TexasBarCLE shall provide to applicants who attend the entire course as described above.
