ORDER OF APPOINTMENT


Under the authority of 28 U.S.C. §631 et seq., with the approval of the Court, and after compliance with the requirements established by the Judicial Conference of the United States, it is

ORDERED that Diana Song Quiroga be, and she is hereby appointed as United States Magistrate Judge with official station at Laredo, Texas, at the salary fixed by law. Magistrate Judge Song Quiroga shall enter upon the performance of her duties on January 4, 2012, provided that, prior to the commencement of such duties, she shall take the oath or affirmation as prescribed by 28 U.S.C. §§453 and 631(g).

Magistrate Judge Song Quiroga is to hold the office for a term of eight (8) years from the date she assumes office, unless sooner removed pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. §631(I).

The Clerk of Court will furnish certified copies of this Order to the several divisions of this court, to United States Magistrate Judge Diana Song Quiroga, and to the Director of the Administrative Office of the United States District Court, as provided by 28 U.S.C. §631(h).
