ORDER

Pursuant to General Order 2004-5, the Court adopts increased fixed fees and revised forms to be utilized in conjunction with Chapter 13 cases. Any Chapter 13 case filed on or after December 1, 2023, may utilize either (1) Bankruptcy Rule 2016(b) Disclosures and Application for Approval of Standard Fixed Fee Agreements (Local Form 13-10) or (2) Bankruptcy Rule 2016(b) Disclosures and Application for Approval of Non-Standard Fixed Fee Agreements (Local Form 13-11). Alternatively, pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 330(a)(4)(B), debtor's counsel may file an hourly fee application for services rendered subject to the requirements of that section.
