IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Court ADOPTS the attached Schedule A (Military Reservations) and B-1 (Padre Island National Seashore) Providing for Forfeiture of Collateral in Lieu of Appearance. These schedules are adopted in accordance with Rule 58(d) of the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure and Criminal Local Rule CrLR58.1. All prior versions of Schedules A and B-1 are hereby VACATED.

Any person or organization charged with a misdemeanor or petty offense for which there is not a published schedule must appear before a United States District or Magistrate Judge.
