**ORDER ON STIPULATION TO EXTEND TIME FOR CERTAIN OFFICER
AND DIRECTOR DEFENDANTS TO ANSWER OR OTHERWISE
RESPOND TO CROSS-CLAIMS AND THIRD-PARTY COMPLAINT
FOR CONTRIBUTION AND INDEMNIFICATION**

Based on the Stipulation to Extend Time for Certain Officer and Director Defendants to Answer or Otherwise Respond to Cross-Claims and Third-Party Complaint for Contribution and Indemnification between Kenneth L. Lay, Jeffrey K. Skilling, Lou L. Pai, Joseph W. Sutton, Mark A. Frevert, Richard B. Buy, Jeffrey McMahon, and Lawrence Greg Whalley (collectively, the "Officer and Director Defendants") and JPMorgan Chase & Co., J.P. Morgan Securities Inc., JPMorgan Chase Bank, N.A., Citigroup Inc., Citibank, N.A., Citigroup Global Markets Inc., Citigroup Global Markets Limited, Credit Suisse First Boston LLC, Credit Suisse First Boston (USA), Inc., Pershing LLC, Canadian Imperial Bank of Commerce, CIBC World Markets Corp., CIBC World Markets plc, Merrill Lynch & Co., Inc., Merrill Lynch, Pierce, Fenner & Smith Incorporated, Barclays PLC, Barclays Bank PLC, Barclays Capital Inc., Lehman Brothers Holdings Inc., and Lehman Brothers Inc. (collectively, the "Bank Defendants"), it is ordered that the Officer and Director Defendants shall have until June 2, 2005 to answer or otherwise respond to the Bank Defendants' Cross-Claims and Third-Party Complaint for Contribution and Indemnification.
