
**ORDER GRANTING EMERGENCY MOTION

The Court, having considered the Emergency Motion to Stay Deposition of Kevin A. Howard and the arguments of counsel, the pleadings on file, and any other relevant matter, determines that the Motion should be GRANTED.

It is **ORDERED** that the Defendant Kevin A. Howard's Deposition scheduled for November 23, 2005 is STAYED as to Defendant Kevin A. Howard pending resolution of his Motion to Dismiss, the conclusion of his criminal trial, or a postponement of the May trial setting in the subject proceeding.

Kevin A. Howard's Deposition is reset for September 1, 2006, with a reservation of rights to make appropriate Motions based upon the status of the three events identified above.
