

**ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION PROVIDER OPEN ENROLLMENT
APPLICATION DEADLINE EXTENDED TO FEBRUARY 14, 2020**

The Court will entertain applications from attorneys seeking to be added to the Court's Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) Provider List as a Court approved ADR Provider.

The application period is from December 1, 2018 through February 14, 2019.

To be eligible for initial listing as an ADR provider, the applicant must meet the following minimum qualifications:

- Membership in the bar of the United States District Court for the Southern District of Texas;
- Licensed to practice law for at least ten years; and
- Completion of at least forty hours training in dispute resolution techniques in an alternative dispute resolution course approved by the State Bar of Texas Minimum Continuing Legal Education department.
