

Instructions: Abstract of Judgment

A. List the name(s) of the plaintiff(s). If space does not permit a complete listing, write the name of the first listed plaintiff followed by “,et al,”.

B. List the name(s) of the defendant(s). If space does not permit a complete listing, write the name of the first listed defendant followed by “,et al.”.

C. Enter the civil action number of the case in which Judgment was entered. The case number may be entered in two forms:

- (1) [Division]:[Year]-cv-[Action Number]
(ex. 4:12-cv-8000)
(or)
- (2) [Division]-[Year]-[Action Number]
(ex. H-12-8000).

The Divisional Offices of the Southern District of Texas are listed here by divisional code and city-name:

- (1) B - Brownsville
- (2) C - Corpus Christi
- (3) G - Galveston
- (4) H - Houston
- (5) L - Laredo
- (6) M - McAllen
- (7) V - Victoria

D. Enter the date of entry of judgment on the docket. **Note: this date may be later than the date the judgment was signed.**

E. Enter the name of the party/parties to whom the judgment was awarded. **This information must match the judgment exactly.**

F. Enter the name of the party against whom the judgment was entered. **This information must match the judgment exactly.**

G. Enter the **exact** amount of the money judgment awarded.

H. Enter the **exact** amount of costs awarded in the judgment.

I. If applicable, enter the rate of interest as indicated in the Judgment.

If not indicated in the Judgment:

Interest on any money judgment in a civil case recovered in district court is calculated from the date of entry of judgment, at a rate equal to the weekly average 1-year constant maturity Treasury Yield, as published by the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System, for the calendar week preceding the date of the judgment [28 USC § 1961]. Please see 28 USC § 1961(b) & (c) for exceptions and further considerations necessary for the correct application and calculation of the rate of interest specified. See also 40 USC § 3114-3118 for calculation of interest on compensation arising from the purchase of land or any interest in land by the Federal Government.

J. Enter the total amount of the outstanding award paid to-date by the judgment debtor to the judgment creditor.

K. This box is best left blank. Enter of the total amount of money judgment outstanding, calculated with interest, up to the date of issuance. **Note:** if a total amount of money judgment due is entered, any interest amounts accrued after the date of issuance will not be reflected in the Abstract of Judgment.
