This program offers medication related services including prescription medication management, administration, training and support services as well as ongoing medication monitoring. Brazoria County Individual Rehabilitation Services -Admission Criteria: •Meet priority population as defined by DSHS; and •Eligibility determined by Uniform Assessment scores completed at intake or by the case manager. This program offers services provided by professional Rehabilitation Specialist and para-professional Rehabilitation Technician mental health staff. Services: symptom management, acquiring the skills to cope with the demands of the environment, strengthening social support networks and tending to essential tasks needed to improve self- sufficiency. The services are tailored to the individual and address specific strengths, needs, and self-stated life goals. Services are provided in individual and small groups.
