Adhering to the Resiliency and Disease Management statewide initiative, this program offers medication related services including prescription medicine management and administration, medication training and support services as well as ongoing medication monitoring. Galveston County Individual Rehabilitation Services - Admission Criteria: •Meet priority population as defined by Department of Social and Health Services (DSHS); and •Eligibility determined by Uniform Assessment scores completed at intake or by the case manager. This program offers services provided by professional (Rehabilitation Specialist) and para-professional (Rehabilitation Technician) mental health staff. Services are provided to an individual to facilitate the maximum reduction of disability and restoration of the individual to their best possible level of functioning.
