Also new work-related clothing and footwear (scrubs, steel-toed boots, nursing shoes, etc.) may be purchased through local participating retailers. •FOOD: Those who are hungry receive lunch bags and referrals to partner neighborhood food pantries who agree to help MAM clients. MAM staff provides food stamp (SNAP) application assistance. *TRANSPORTATION ASSISTANCE: Provides gasoline vouchers or Metro-money to facilitate travel to work, job interviews or medical appointments. MAM also partners in "Cycle2Success" which makes bicycles available to those who need regular transportation to work.
