WIC promotes breastfeeding and provides special nutrition classes, individual counseling, frequent follow up to high risk clients, health assessment, health care and social service referrals, and immunizations. Nutrition and health education is also provided as well as limited nutritional health screening. Hours: Thursday: 9:00 am - 4:00 pm
