Advisory Fee Schedule: Violations of Duck Blind Permits
at the Wallisville Lake Project

Blinds not removed on time (by March 19, 2001).....	\$ 75.00 plus removal costs
Blinds not removed by April 2, 2001.....	\$150.00 plus removal costs
Blinds not removed by April 16, 2001.....	\$300.00 plus removal costs
Blinds not removed by April 29, 2001.....	Maximum fine plus removal costs (\$500.00) and/or 6 months <u>or both</u>)

These are advisory fines only. Depending upon the circumstances, the maximum penalty could be imposed for any of the above violations.
