ORDER

The Reynaldo G. Garza – Filemon B. Vela U.S. Courthouse in Brownsville, Texas will reopen to the public on Monday, June 1, 2020. The court will continue to utilize remote or virtual proceedings when feasible and in the interests of justice.

The public, employees, and contractors who enter the courthouse must wear masks/face coverings in public areas and in shared workspaces where safe social distancing is not possible. The U.S. Marshals Service may exclude from the courthouse anyone who does not wear a mask/face covering or maintain social distancing. Individuals coming to the courthouse must provide their own masks/face coverings, which will not be available at the courthouse.

The United States District Court for the Southern District of Texas is open for, and is busy carrying out, its work. The court's Electronic Case Filing (ECF) system is not affected, and parties may continue to file electronically and email documents to the clerk's office following the standing orders and other instructions on the court's website.
