ORDER

To protect the health and safety of the public, staff, and judicial officers in the face of the COVID-19 pandemic, and in accordance with the Federal Judiciary's COVID-19 Recovery Guidelines: federal, state, and local orders and guidance; and public health guidance and information, it is ORDERED that the Reynaldo G. Garza - Filemon B. Vela U.S. Courthouse in Brownsville, Texas will be closed to the public until further notice and contingent on circumstances permitting reopening then as planned. The court will continue to encourage remote or virtual proceedings when feasible and in the interests of justice.

During the closure to the public, employees and contractors who enter either the courthouse must wear masks or face coverings in public areas and in shared workspaces where safe social distancing is not possible. When the courthouses reopen to the public, it will be subject to conditions such as wearing face masks in the building and following safe social distancing guidelines.

The United States District Court for the Southern District of Texas is open for, and is busy carrying out, its work. The court's Electronic Case Filing (ECF) system is not affected by the closure, and parties may continue to file electronically and email documents to the clerk's office following the standing orders and other instructions on the court's website.
