SPECIAL ORDER C-2021-05

ORDER


This Order applies in the Corpus Christi Division of the Southern District of Texas and supersedes Special Order C-2021-04.


Effective August 4, 2021, all individuals who enter the United States Courthouse in Corpus Christi, Texas must wear a mask and practice social distancing in courthouse public areas. Mask wearing inside courtrooms and chambers are at the discretion of each presiding judicial officer. This order applies to employees, contractors, jurors and prospective jurors, lawyers, litigants, witnesses, family members, court observers, and other members of the public.

This order is subject to the district-wide policy for the Southern District of Texas requiring all courthouse employees who work with venire panels and jurors to be both vaccinated and masked.

This order remains in place subject to further court order.
