

AMENDED CLOSURE ORDER

To protect the health and safety of the public, staff, and judicial officers from exposure to or spread of COVID-19, it is ORDERED that the Bob Casey U.S. Courthouse in Houston, Texas is closed to all tenants, contractors, and persons who work at the courthouse, with the exception of judges and their staff they expressly authorize to enter the premises, until April 27, 2020. The Bob Casey U.S. Courthouse will continue to be closed to the public until May 4, 2020. Unless further developments cause another delay, the Bob Casey U.S. Courthouse will reopen to tenants on Monday, April 27, 2020, and reopen to the public on Monday, May 4, 2020.

Despite the physical closure of the building, The United States District Court for the Southern District of Texas remains open for official business. The court's Electronic Case Filing (ECF) system is not affected by the closure, and parties may continue to file electronically and email documents to the Clerk's Office pursuant to the standing orders and other instructions on the court's website.
