Houston, Texas - The district judges of the United States District Court for the Southern District of Texas voted to name David J. Bradley as the Clerk of Court.

The clerk is the court's chief executive officer and is responsible for providing all support services for the district's 42 judges and 265 employees. The clerk's office is headquartered in Houston, Texas and serves 43 contiguous counties with divisional offices in Brownsville, Corpus Christi, Galveston, Laredo, McAllen and Victoria.

Mr. Bradley has served the Southern District of Texas with distinction for 27 years in various capacities and as Chief Deputy Clerk since 1983. He received his bachelor's degree from Methodist College in Fayetteville, North Carolina and his law degree from Hamline University Law School. He succeeds Michael Milby who left in June 2009 to accept a position with the Administrative Office of the U.S. Courts in Washington, D.C.
