**ORDER
FOR E-WAGE DEDUCTION**

Pursuant to Bankruptcy Local Rules 1007-1(c) and 3015-1(c) _____ (“Debtor(s)”) have enrolled in the Chapter 13 Trustee’s electronic funds transfer program (“EFT”), opting for the eWage Deduction Order option for Debtor(s) form of automatic payment despite (i) not being self-employed or (ii) receiving wage or salary income in an amount equal to or greater than the Debtor(s)’ monthly plan payment. Accordingly, it is therefore

ORDERED that:

- 1. The Debtor(s) is ordered to pay to the Chapter 13 Trustee by eWage Deduction Order the following amount:

Monthly	Semi-monthly	Bi-Weekly	Weekly

- 2. This amount must be increased or decreased by the Debtor(s) without further order to reflect the amounts due under any (i) amended proposed plan; (ii) proposed modification of a plan; or (iii) Notice of Plan Payment Adjustment, except to the extent stayed by Court order.
- 3. Debtor(s) must remit timely payments to the Chapter 13 Trustee via eWage Deduction Order, failure of which, the eWage Deduction Order shall be automatically terminated and Debtor(s) must file a timely Wage Order or EFT form of payment after such termination.
- 4. The Debtor(s) may not terminate this eWage Deduction Order except as further ordered by the Court.
