Applications are now being accepted for the position of Federal Public Defender for the Western District of Texas vice Henry J. Bemporad. The Federal Public Defender will be appointed by the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit. The term of appointment (and reappointment) is four years. The annual salary is \$155,500 with full federal benefits.

After appointment, the Federal Public Defender may not engage in the private practice of law.
